PARACHUTIST COMPETITION IN ACCURACY CUP OF FREEDOM PILSEN



GENERAL INFORMATION:

- → The competition date is August 22nd- 23rd August 2020
- → Registration form must be filled at https://www.aplzen.cz/event/pilsener-cup/ . Register the team or as single competitor in the same form
- ✤ Five parachutists per team. Single competitors will be grouped to the teams according to their personal and language preferences
- → Presentation of the competitors is at Pilsen Líně Airport at August 21th, 2020, 1800 2200 (LKLN, Plzeňská 145, 330 21 Líně, M7JJ+C7 Líně, GPS 49.681148, 13.280720)
- Entry fee 170EUR pro person is payable at the presentation. It covers all competition jumps (eight jumps and all rejumps) and social event. For jump not provided the organizer returns 13EUR
- → Plane helicopter Airbus H125 B3e
- → The competition is provided in accordance with FAI rules, Czech national directive V-PARA-1 and this plan. Minimum 3 rounds to finish the competition
- Target will be located at GPS 49.715623, 13.354645 in open and safe area, covered by grass. Measurement up to one meter. Up to 16 cm with Automatic Measuring Device (AMD) with a two-centimeter-diameter dead-center target, 16cm to 1 meter manually. Video recording is used
- \rightarrow Wind speed limit for the jumps is 6m/s
- → The competition categories: Teams (five members) and Individuals: men, women, juniors (the condition of the announcement is a minimum number of 4 competitors in the category)
- → Determining the individual Winner: Individuals-the winner is the person with the lowest sum of distances. In case of tie three top individuals, the winner is person with more dead centers. If tie cannot be broken, winner is the person with higher number of next lowest distance-1cm, etc.
- → Determining the Winning Team: The winning team is the one with the lowest sum of distances. In case of tie three top teams the same rule as with individuals apply.
- → Protests: a) The protest may be given in written form to the hands of Chief Judge or the Director of the Competition. The protest fee is 37 EUR. In the event of non-recognition of the protest, the fee is collected by the organizer. b) The protest must be given within thirty minutes from the cause. c) The protest decides the vote of the JURY commission, composed



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of the team captains, referees and the main referee. In the event of a roll-call vote, the voice of the Chief Judge decides.

- Training camp: 17. 8. 15:00- 19:00, 18.-21.8.2020, 9:00 19:00, at Pilsen Líně Airport, (LKLN), jump price 12EUR, training plane Antonov An 2, registration for the training jumps is required (mail to:) info@aplzen.cz. Training jumps can be provided on Monday August 17th, if there is sufficient number of jumpers
- → Accommodation is organised individually, the camp site is available (free of charge, electricity, showers and toilet facilities are available) in the designated area of Plzeň Líně Airport (49.680951, 13.282158). Transportation to the target area (approx. 7 km distance is provided individually, convoy of vehicles will be organised). No camping around the target area
- ✤ If a competition will be postponed or canceled completely, organizer will publish it on the website at least 30 days before the competition
- → The competition is held under the patronage of the Mayor of the City of Pilsen, Mr. Mgr. Martina Baxa
