GENERAL INFORMATION:

- ➔ Application form for the competition (in free form) must be send to info@aplzen.cz not later than April 24, 2020.
- ➔ Entry fee **120EUR /3000 CZK** should be paid to account number 722112389 / 5500 (indicate the name of the team or the name of the competitor, IBAN: CZ5755000000000722112389, SWIFT: RZBCCZPP) not later than April 24, 2020.
- ➔ Entry fee after April 24, 2020 is 150 EUR/ 3700 and is payable at the latest at the registration.
- ➔ The fee covers 8 competition jumps + eventual rejumps.
- ➔ Refund for jump not made is 250Kč (10 EUR).
- ➔ Payment is possible in both Česká koruna (CZK) or Euro (EUR) currencies and in cash only (no credit cards¹).
- ➔ Accommodation: individually organized by the competitors. Camping free of charge is possible at designed Area of Plzeň Líně Airfield (LKLN). The transport to the target are is individual, not provided by the organiser.
- ➔ No camping around the target area.
- ➔ **Training jumps: May 5th - 8th, 9 a.m. - 19 p.m., Plzeň Líně airfield (LKLN).** The jump cost is 325CZK (13EUR). The airplane for training jumps is Antonov An 2.
- ➔ **Cup of Freedom is a part of Liberation Festival Pilsen 2020** (<http://slavnostisvobody.cz>)

1. Purpose and meaning of the competition:

- a) To determine the winner and the ranking of individual competitors and teams of five competitors in accuracy landing on the basis of the results achieved
- b) To obtain the points to the CZECH PARACHUTING CUP SERIES 2020
- c) To compare the performance of competitors and motivate them further to increase their performance
- d) To promote the parachuting sport to the public
- e) To consolidate friendly relationships and general sporting spirit

2. Location and date of the competition:

- a) Plzeň Líně Airfield (LKLN), (49°40'51.5"N 13°16'55.6"E - 49.680960, 13.282119) the landing area is ŠKODALAND PARK in Plzeň (49°42'56.6"N 13°21'15.8"E - 49.715733, 13.354378).
- b) The competition date is May 9th.- 10th, 2020

3. Timetable (subject to change):

- May 5th, 8th 9 a.m. - 19.p.m. Training jumps Plzeň Líně airfield (LKLN)
- May 8th, 6 p.m. - 21 p.m. Registration of the competitors, Plzeň Líně airfield (LKLN)
- May 9th, 8:30 a.m. Briefing of the teamleaders (ŠKODALAND PARK)
- May 9th, 9 a.m. - 6 p. m. First call, competition jumps (ŠKODALAND PARK)
- May 9th, 8 p.m. Social evening
- May 10th, 9 a.m. - 1 p.m. Competition jumps (ŠKODALAND PARK)
- May 10th, 2 p.m. Awarding Ceremony (ŠKODALAND PARK)

4. Technical details of the competition:

- a) The competition is provided in accordance with FAI rules, Czech national directive V-PARA-1 and this plan
- b) Landing on the tuffet, measurement up to 16 cm with Automatic Measuring Device (AMD) with a two-centimeter-diameter dead-center target.
- c) Wind speed limit for the jumps is 6 m/s.
- d) Competition jumps will be provided from helicopter **Airbus H125B3e**
- e) The competitor is responsible for exit form the plane in corresponding altitude. Breaking the minimal exit altitude rule is not a reason for the rejump.



- f) All competitors must have equipment in accordance with applicable regulations. The organizer has the right to disqualify a competitor for noncompliance with parachuting sport regulations.

5. Rules of the competition:

- a) 8 rounds for each team
- b) Minimum 3 rounds
- c) Altitude 900 m – 1200 m AGL
- d) Achieved results of the competition rounds are evaluated in accordance with the FAI Sporting Code and the competition rules for landing accuracy (classical disciplines- accuracy)

6. The competition will be in the following categories:

- **Teams (five members)**
- **Individuals: men, women, juniors** (the condition of the announcement is a minimum number of 4 competitors in the category)

7. Determining the Winner

Individuals - the winner is the person with the lowest sum of distances. In case of tie three top individuals, the winner is person with more dead centers. If tie cannot be broken, winner is the person with higher number of next lowest distance- 1cm, etc.

Teams - the winning team is the one with the lowest sum of distances. In case of tie three top teams the same rule as with individuals apply.

8. Protests:

- a) The protest may be given in written form to the hands of Chief Judge or the Director of the Competition. The protest fee is CZK 500 or 20 EUR. In the event of non-recognition of the protest, the fee is collected by the organizer
- b) The protest must be given within thirty minutes from the occurrence of the cause
- c) The protest decides the vote of the JURY commission, composed of the team captains and the main referee. In the event of a roll-call vote, the voice of the Chief Judge shall be decided.
