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GENERAL INFORMATION:

- **Application** for the competition (in free e-mail form) must be send to info@aplzen.cz not later than **May 7th, 2021, 21:00.**
- **Entry Fee** – 3000Kč should be paid to account number 722112389 / 5500 (indicate the name of the team or the name of the competitor, IBAN: CZ5755000000000722112389, SWIFT: RZBCCZPP) or in cash at the registration. It covers jumps, rejumps and organizational services.
- **Accommodation** – individually organized by the competitors. Camping free of charge is possible at designed Area of Plzeň Líně Airfield (LKLN).
- **Board** – meals can be ordered at the airfield during registration.
- **Training jumps: May 4th - 7th** . The jump cost is 330CZK. The airplane for training jumps is Antonov An 2.



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1. Purpose and meaning of the competition:

- a) To determine the winner and the ranking of individual competitors and teams of five competitors in accuracy landing on the basis of the results achieved.
- b) To obtain the points to the CZECH PARACHUTING CUP SERIES 2021.
- c) To compare the performance of competitors and motivate them further to increase their performance.
- d) To promote the parachuting sport to the public.
- e) To consolidate friendly relationships and general sporting spirit.

2. Location and date of the competition:

- a) Plzeň Líně Airfield (LKLN), (49.681063, 13.280795, Google maps M7JJ+C7 Líně).
- b) The competition date is May 7th.- 8th, 2021.

5. Technical details of the competition:

- a) The competition is provided in accordance with FAI rules, Czech national directive V-PARA-1 and this plan.
- b) Landing on the tuffet, measurement up to 16 cm with Automatic Measuring Device (AMD) with a two-centimeter-diameter dead-center target.
- c) Wind speed limit for the jumps is 7 m/s.
- d) Competition jumps will be provided from the plane AN2.
- e) The competitor is responsible for exit form the plane in corresponding altitude. Breaking the minimal exit altitude rule is not a reason for the rejump.



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- f) All competitors must have equipment in accordance with applicable regulations. The organizer has the right to disqualify a competitor for noncompliance with parachuting sport regulations.

6. Rules of the competition:

- a) 8 rounds for each team.
- b) Minimum 3 rounds.
- c) Altitude 900 m – 1200 m AGL.
- d) Achieved results of the competition rounds are evaluated in accordance with the FAI Sporting Code and the competition rules for landing accuracy (classical disciplines- accuracy).

7. The competition will be in the following categories:

- **Teams (five members).**
- **Individuals: men, women, juniors** (the condition of the announcement is a minimum number of 4 competitors in the category).

8. Determining the Winner

Individuals - the winner is the person with the lowest sum of distances. In case of tie three top individuals, the winner is person with more dead centers. If tie cannot be broken, winner is the person with higher number of next lowest distance- 1cm, etc.

Teams - the winning team is the one with the lowest sum of distances. In case of tie three top teams the same rule as with individuals apply.

9. Protests:

- a) The protest may be given in written form to the hands of Chief Judge or the Director of the Competition. The protest fee is CZK 500 or 20 EUR. In the event of non-recognition of the protest, the fee is collected by the organizer
- b) The protest must be given within thirty minutes from the occurrence of the cause.
- c) The protest decides the vote of the JURY commission, composed of the team captains and the main referee. In the event of a roll-call vote, the voice of the Chief Judge shall be decided.



10. Measures again the COVID 19:

The organizer must keep an informative overview of all participants both competitors and organizers in advance. Upon arrival, everyone must undergo a PCR test or document the disease course (not older than 90 days) or prove the vaccination.

A record will be made of each test performed. Due to the length of the race (7 days including training), it is necessary that each participant, including the organizational staff, undergoes a test at intervals of 3 days. The start of the interval is the date of the first test on the arrival of the airfield. The organizer will secure that new arriving personnel are not in contact with already tested personnel.

Exceptions to testing:

(a) persons who have undergone laboratory-confirmed COVID-19, are after an isolation period in accordance with the applicable rules of the Ministry of Health, show no symptoms of COVID-19, and since the first positive POC antigen SARS-CoV-2 test no more time has elapsed than 90 days

b) persons who have a certificate issued for vaccination against COVID-19 and at least 14 days since the application of the second dose of vaccine (in the case of a two-dose schedule), or 14 days since the first dose of vaccine (in the case of a single dose schedule), and the vaccinated person does not show any symptoms of COVID-19.

Positive results of the test:

If the result of the preventive test for SARS-CoV-2 virus antigen performed by the organizer is positive, the participant is obliged to proceed according to the valid measure of the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic, regulating obligations in testing for SARS-CoV-2 virus antigen self testing.

Places where person has been or may have been located must be disinfected immediately outside the normal cleaning plan. Any person who has met an infected person must be tested immediately outside the usual testing plan.

In any case, it is necessary to ensure that the person with the positive test leaves the airport areas as soon as possible and to minimize the possibility of meeting other participants. Arrival and departure of foreign participants and their teams are governed by the regulations in force at the time of their arrival and departure. During the competition period, the organizer provides meals and drinking regime directly on the airfield by a contracted food company.

The presence of spectators or the public during the competition and during the of one week period before the competition is forbidden.
